

MEGHAL MAHESH PATEL: DESIGNING WITH EMPATHY, PURPOSE, AND QUIET CONFIDENCE

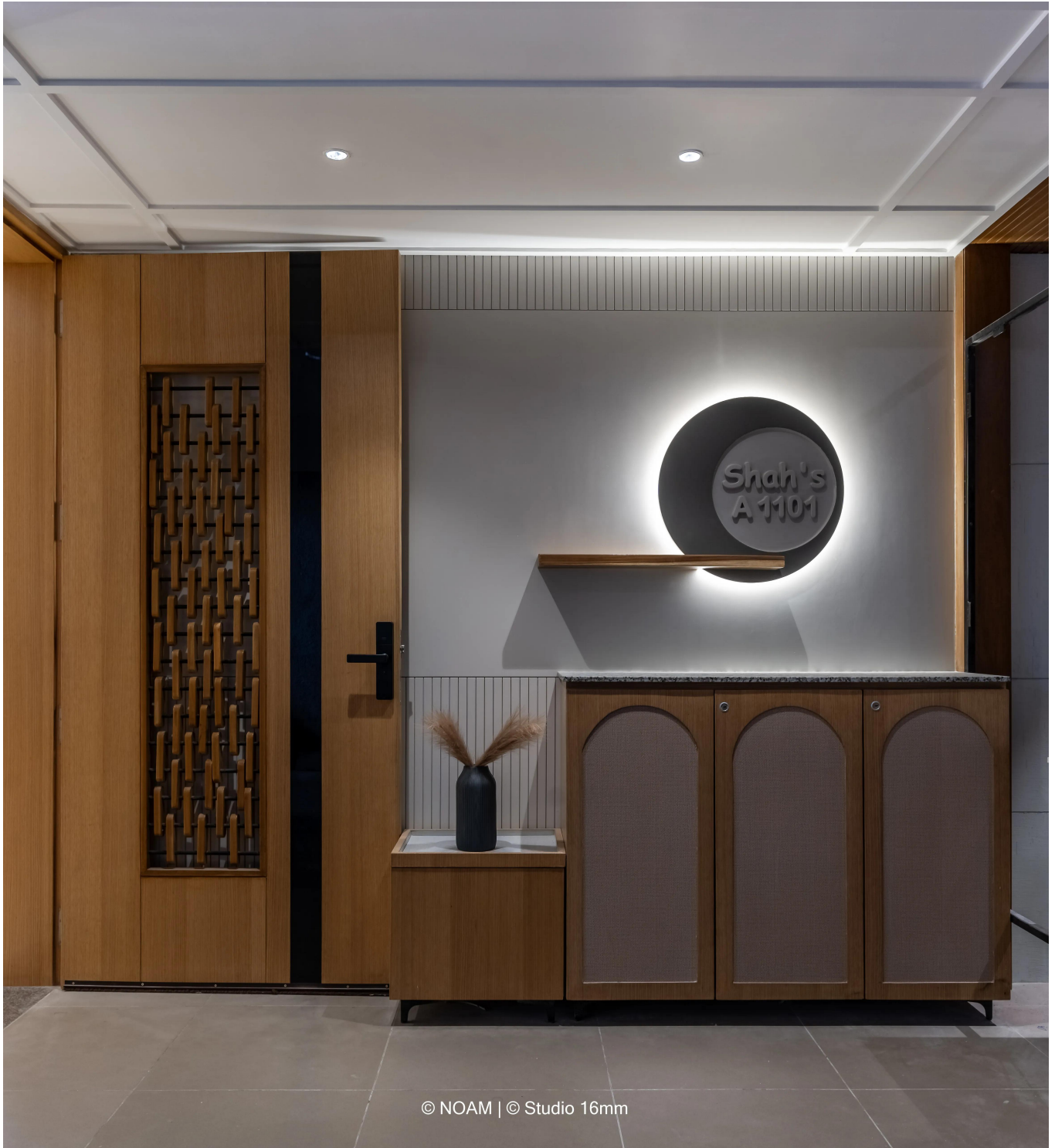
